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To Whom It May Concern

The World Food Programme in South Sudan purchased 50 institutional stoves from Instove in 2012 for a pilot project in the school feeding programme. This recommendation is being written based on feedback received from our field representatives who have had the opportunity to observe the Instove institutional cooking stoves in use.

We have received positive feedback from the schools where the Instove institutional stove was put into service. Cooks and kitchen staff report that:

- (a) the institutional stoves conserve heat and therefore reduce firewood consumption
- (b) the stoves cook faster than the traditional 'three-stone' method and therefore save time
- (c) the stove produces very little smoke compared to the traditional method and hence a provides a healthier and better cooking experience for the school cooks

Based on these observations I am happy to recommend the Instove institutional stoves as a solution for high volume cooking requirements that conserves firewood and reduces smoke emissions.
